Eligibility: All juniors, seniors and beginning graduate students are eligible. Appropriate fields of study include Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science and Engineering.

\$4000 of financial support plus housing, travel and tuition for Qualified **Minority** Students: **NIH defines minority groups that are under-represented in the sciences as African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans (including Alaska Natives) and natives of the Pacific Islands. To be eligible for minority support applicants must be US citizens or permanent residents.*
