



FELLOWSHIP IN ITALIAN STUDIES

Academic Year 2014-2015

Deadline: March 28, 2014

Fellowships, based on a two tier system, will be awarded through a competitive process:

TIER 1—\$3,000

Students must be a declared Italian minor or major in Language and Culture with an Italian option, and:

- Be a CSUN full-time undergraduate or graduate student currently enrolled in Italian Section courses
- Have a 3.2 GPA in Italian courses at time of application
- Have completed two Italian language courses prior to application
- Enroll in Italian courses two consecutive semesters following the awarding of the fellowship

TIER 2— \$2,000 (as funds permit)

Students have demonstrated interest in Italian courses and program, and who would like to continue with their study of Italian language and culture but need financial support. In addition, students must:

- Be a CSUN full-time undergraduate or graduate student currently enrolled in Italian Section courses
- Have a 3.0 GPA in Italian courses at time of application
- Have completed one Italian language course prior to application
- Enroll in two courses offered by the Italian Program the academic year following the awarding of the fellowship (one of the two courses must be an Italian language course)

To apply, please submit the following to the MCLL main office, Sierra Tower 405/407:

- Italian Studies Scholarship Application (download from www.csun.edu/mcll)
- Statement of purpose: a one-page typed, double-spaced essay, indicating why applicant considers the study of Italian language and culture important
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a CSUN Italian Studies faculty member
- Degree Progress Report
- Additional transcripts as needed

**Students who do not receive an award the first time may reapply the following year.*
