You'll be asked to provide our group number, # 5138820-101., which is through CSURMA, and your Social Security number. The representative will assist you in locating a participating plan attorney in your area, and provide you with an authorization number you'll need when you or your spouse makes an appointment. (You may also use a non-participating attorney and receive reimbursement for covered services according to a set fee schedule. In this case, you will be responsible for any of the out-of-network fees that exceed the reimbursed amount.)
