JOB DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Safety Manager will ensure ongoing development and maintenance of training a safety and environmental programs to include:

- 1. Maintain OSHA compliance with the following topics in mind
- Perform routine job safety analysis, building safety inspections and reviews;
- Emergency Action Plans;
- Fire Prevention Program;
- Hazard Communication Program;
- Personal Protective Equipment Program;
- Maintain training documentation.
- 2. Assist in maintaining safety guidelines, procedures, and policies
- Able to effectively communicate both safety and environmental training topics.
- Ensure and monitor regulatory issues. (i.e., DNR, EPA, DOT)
- Provide initial new-hire safety training and follow-up interaction for new employees.
- Assists the Company with accident management and prevention.
- Maintain and file documentation needed for reporting to controlling agencies.
- Able to interpret and decipher environmental permit requirements.
- Travel other OB locations to conduct inspections and training on a scheduled basis.

Knowledge, Skills, Abilities and Personal Characteristics:

- Knowledge of federal, state, and local loss prevention regulations.
- Verbal and written communication skills.
- Interpersonal/human relations skills.
- Planning/organizational skills.
- Ability to design, implement, and control a safety program.
- Ability to conduct safety inspections of buildings and equipment.

Other Responsibilities:

- 1. After re-establishing the Company Safety Committee, provides regulations and technical consultation regarding health and safety issues to employees.
- 2. Develops programs to ensure the company's compliance with federal, state, and local safety-related regulations, in addition to other environmental health, safety, and loss prevention standards and guidelines.
- 3. Conducts claims investigations and evaluates risk management claims information to identify significant hazards and loss trends; identifies and recommends preventive measures and corrective actions.
- 4. Performs regular physical inspections of grounds, buildings, equipment, and operations company-wide; identifies hazards and incidents of regulatory non-compliance, and recommends corrective measures.
- 5. Provides ongoing safety and loss prevention training to all locations to reduce the frequency and severity of accidental losses.
- 6. Manage Workers Comp claims company-wide and work closely with third party carriers.

This position requires a self-starter with strong safety knowledge and the ability to work productively with no supervision. Must work well under pressure and handle constant interruptions. Must be able to prioritize a variety of projects and tasks. Must have strong oral, written and interpersonal skills for communication.
