Perform dosimetry tasks to include the collection and distribution of dosimeters, process and data enter change / transfer / deletion requests, return collected dosimeters to film badge vendor for processing. Communicate effectively, both in writing and verbally, and possess organizational skills necessary to maintain the dosimetry program. Collect and prepare radioactive waste for disposition, perform radiation safety survey measurements, and analyze and collect samples for counting with spectrometric instruments. Develop and maintain timely records via log books, forms, and computer. Occasional technical memoranda must be written using knowledge of radiation terms. Other duties as assigned by Senior Health Physicist or the Radiation Safety Officer.
