Community Engagement Page

Below is a mock up of a potential web page. Its purpose would be to show community engagement of faculty and staff from your college. Would your college be interested in having a link to such site on your college's homepage as a pilot? The mock up was created by Trevor Greenleaf under Steve Fitzgerald based on an idea by Steve Graves.

The pilot project would entail the following...

- 1) placement of a webpage that highlights the Community Engagement activities of faculty members with a particular college.
 - the particular web page would be part of the Colleges Web Site
- 2) A link on the web page, would allow a faculty member to voluntarily complete the Graves's survey
 - when the data is entered a new balloon would be automatically added to the map. Moving the cursor over the balloon would display information about the specific project.
- 3) Each Dean, associated with the pilot, would communicate with their faculty about the Community Engagement page, and encourage participation.

As part of the pilot, we would

- a) obtain more data for the mapping project
- b) determine if more resources should be put into the project




