- ***Publications*** — Dr. Steve Oppenheimer along with his students Azalia Contreras and John Vitale, his technician Virginia Hutchins-Carroll, and collaborator Dr. Edward Carroll (CSUN Dept. Chemistry and Biochemistry) have had a paper accepted for publication in the journal *Zygote*
- ***Chancellor’s Doctoral Incentive Program for CSU Students*** — The Chancellor's Doctoral Incentive/Forgivable Loan Program (CDI/FLP) provides student loans to a limited number of individuals pursuing full-time doctoral study at accredited universities throughout the United States.

The program seeks to provide loans to doctoral students who are interested in applying and competing for CSU instructional faculty positions after completion of the doctoral degree. Loans obtained through this program are repayable over a 15-year period, following completion of the degree or withdrawal from doctoral study. The program also offers the potential for loan forgiveness. If a participant applies, competes for, and is hired in a CSU instructional faculty position after completion of the doctoral degree, 20 percent of the loan will be forgiven for each year of full-time postdoctoral teaching employment in the CSU.
