AMC 386. SURVEY OF THE ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY (3)

Focuses on the roles and interactions of creative artists, business professionals, engineers, and computer scientists in the entertainment industry. Up to two different sections of this course may be taken for credit including but not limited to the following areas: A- Producing commercials for local small businesses; B - Producing television promos and trailers; C - Theme park creation, design and operation; D - Producing electronic press kits; E - Sports programming creation, design, and production; F - From feature film to stage: content and marketing challenges. Credit is allowed for only two of the following courses: AMC 286 or MSE 286. (Crosslisted with MSE 386).
