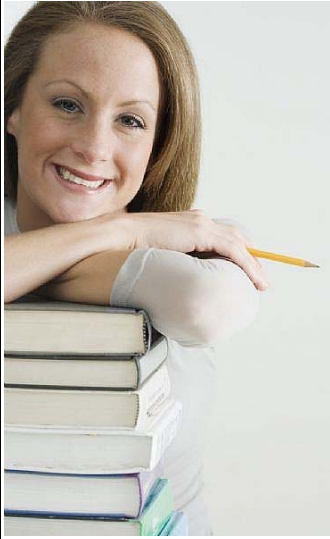


Graduate Student Teaching Opportunities



Students who are hired MUST:

- Be in one of our graduate programs officially (Clinical, HF, or GE)**
- Be in good standing (GPA > 3.0)**
- Classified** (not conditionally classified -- we MIGHT be able to make an exception, but prefer not to)
- Enrolled in the semester they're teaching**



Graduate students who have had the course in Advanced Research Methods (692A), or the equivalent there of, are eligible to apply to become instructors of lab sections in 321 (Research Methods in Psychology). Course instructors will be given manuals to teach from and guided in the grading of APA papers.
