James Ring Scholarship Award

The James Ring Scholarship Award was inaugurated during the spring semester of 2001 and offered annually thereafter. This financial award to Urban Studies and Planning majors is made possible through the donation of James Ring a distinguished alumnus who graduated from the Department of Urban Studies and Planning in the class of 1972. The intent of the award is to help students achieve their academic and career goals. An award of \$500 will be made.

Interested applicants must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Have a minimum of 60 units at the end of the spring semester in which they are applying for the scholarship.
2. Graduating seniors are ineligible.
3. Have a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.2.
4. Have a GPA of at least 3.5 for all courses taken for the Urban Studies and Planning major.
5. Demonstrate meaningful service activity through participation in campus or community organizations.
6. Submit an essay of between 500 words clearing indicating: a) statement of financial need and, b) how the scholarship will assist in achieving career objectives.

Applicants must submit the requested materials by Monday, April 2, 2007. The winner of the award will be announced at the end of year graduation event.
