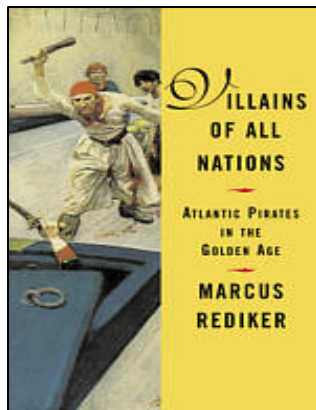
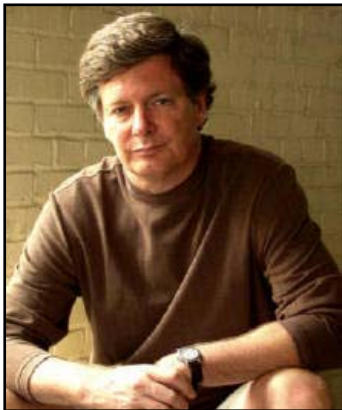

Award-winning historian and University of Pittsburgh professor, Dr. Marcus Rediker, will discuss "Pirates In The Atlantic World: The Real Pirates of the Caribbean."

Professor Rediker is the author of five books and numerous articles on topics related to maritime and labor history. He has given lectures throughout the United States and abroad, in London, Paris, Amsterdam, Milan, Moscow, Sydney, and Tokyo. His writings have been translated into French, German, Greek, Italian, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish and Swedish.

He has explored the "Golden Age" of Atlantic piracy in his book *Villains of All Nations: Atlantic Pirates in the Golden Age*, which focuses on the authentic, as opposed to the Hollywood, history of the men and women who became pirates during the eighteenth century.

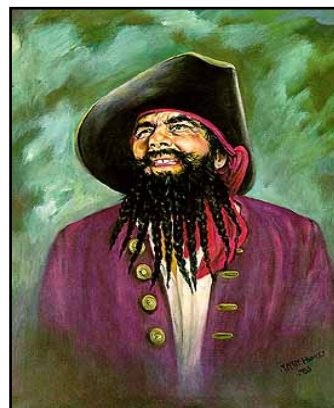
