### ***Eligibility Requirements for TEC Participants:***

- ✓ Serve students with mild/moderate disabilities as a special education teacher
- ✓ Teach at the secondary level (middle or high school)
- ✓ Meet criteria for an intern credential
- ✓ Meet subject matter through an approved program or CSET examination
- ✓ Meet subject matter in a core content area one year after joining the program (e.g. Mathematics, English, Science, Social Science)
