

Subject: Candidates for Emeritus Status

Section 653.2 (page 46) of the Administrative Manual describes the method by which faculty members who have retired or are about to retire can be granted Emeritus Status:

Eligible retired faculty attain Emeritus status upon recommendation by their Department Chair, Department Personnel Committee, College Personnel Committee, or College Dean (or other equivalent administrator); upon review and recommendation by the Personnel Planning and Review Committee, and upon approval by the President of the University.

The Personnel Planning and Review Committee will act on any candidates for Emeritus Status no later than its April 9th meeting in order for necessary arrangements to be completed prior to the conclusion of the academic year.
