

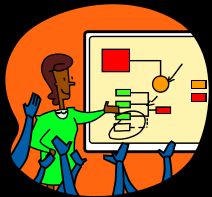

>> Leadership & Life Skills Institute!

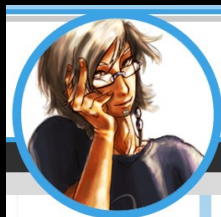
