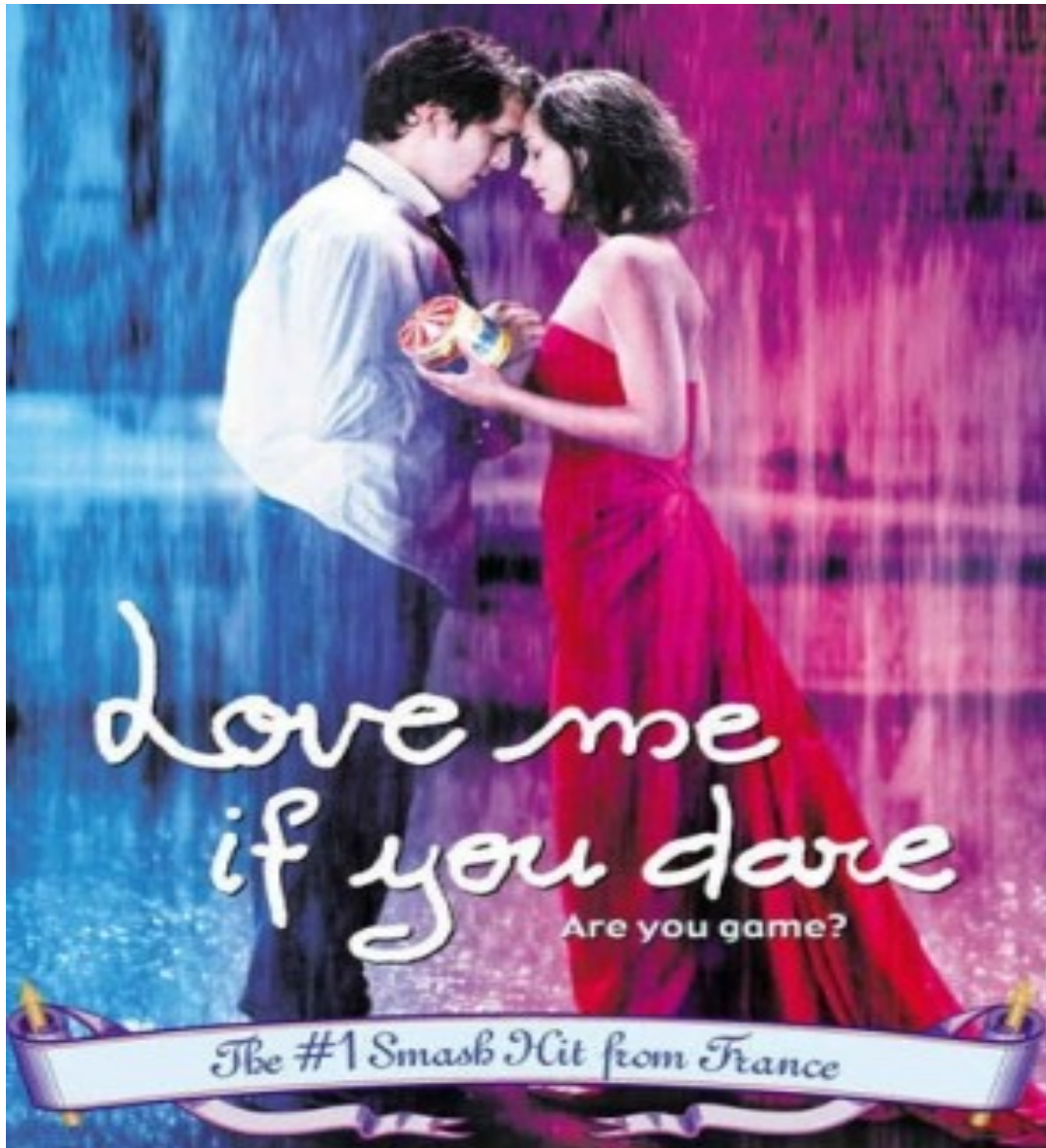
Saturday, Mar 28 — Iron Matador
