

### **INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS**

The Master of Physical Therapy (MPT) program at CSUN is designed for individuals who desire to become eligible for licensure as a physical therapist within the United States (US) and who have completed at least a Bachelor's Degree in some other area. Our MPT Program is entry level and is not appropriate for those who are already trained as physical therapists.

Individuals who have already completed a program leading to a license or a Bachelor's or higher degree in Physical Therapy are not accepted. This is true for those trained in the US and in other countries. The MPT Program at CSUN **does** accept applications from international students who meet qualifications for entry, but **does not** accept those individuals who have already completed a Physical Therapy program in their country.

Physical therapists from the US and from other countries who are seeking advanced degrees or advanced training in Physical Therapy should contact universities or other institutions which offer the advanced or transitional Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree.
