Important:

Extensions must be processed before the completion date on your current I-20 form. We recommend that you submit your I-20 extension request to IESC at least 60 days prior to the expiration date. If approved, you will receive a new I-20 form with an extended expiration/completion of studies date.

It is the student's responsibility to request an extension of stay. According to the USCIS rules, a student may not extend an I-20 after it expires. Students who do not apply for an extension in a timely manner, will lose their legal immigration status. They will then be required to apply for a reinstatement to USCIS.
