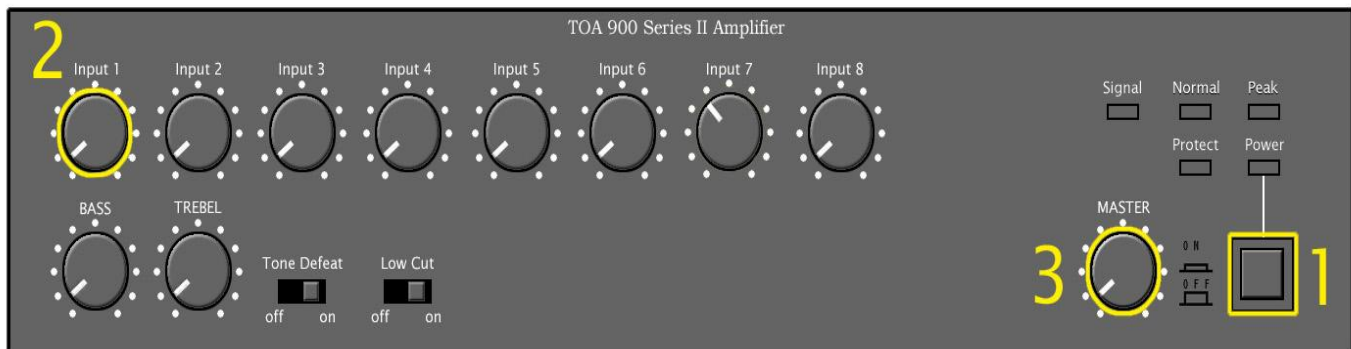
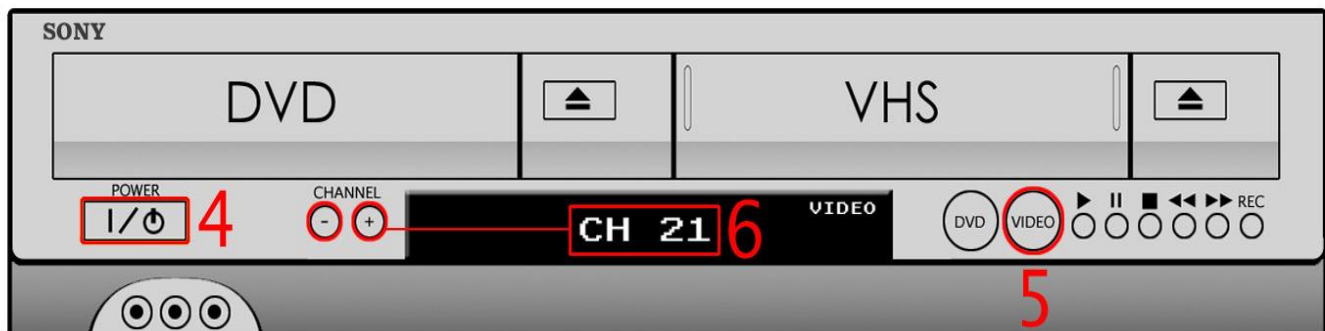

Equipment Preparation

1. Use Mitsubishi remote to turn on the data projector; make sure it is set to **Video**, not DVD
2. Turn on the amplifier
3. Adjust the knob labeled **Input 1** to about 4-5 notches
4. Turn up the Master Volume control knob to desired sound level
5. Turn on the Sony VHS/DVD combo unit
6. Set the VCR to **Video** mode
7. Use Channel up/down button to tune to the **assigned UVN channel**



If UVN scroll appears on screen, proceed to use the phone to activate the UVN system.

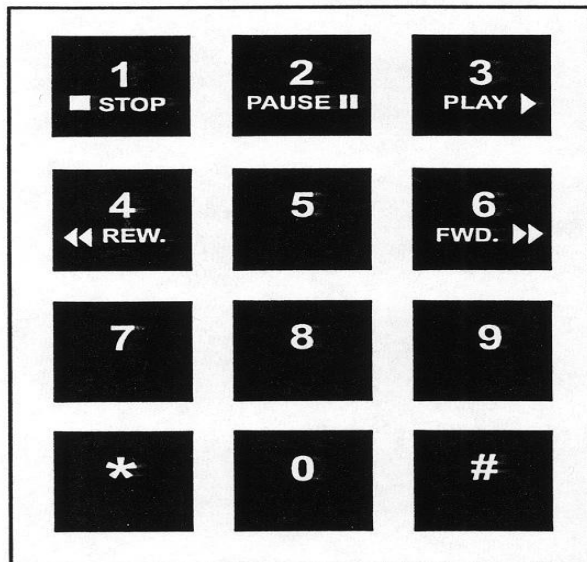
Note: If all settings are correct but there isn't a UVN signal, check to see if **VCR is set on CABLE** using VCR remote (Action or Menu button)

Using the Phone to Access the UVN System

1. Dial assigned phone extension and wait for the beep.
2. Upon hearing the beep, the phone pad becomes your remote control.
3. See diagrams below for number keys and their corresponding functions.
4. Leave phone off the hook during the show so you may use remote functions at any time.
5. When finished, stop the video and hang up the phone.
6. If classroom phone is faulty, use cell phone to activate the system by dialing 1-818-677-EXTENSION
