

## ANDROID 2.2 - ACCESSING CSUN'S ENCRYPTED WIRELESS NETWORK - QUICK GUIDE

### INTRODUCTION

---

This guide provides setup instructions to connect to CSUN's encrypted wireless network (WPA2). Please note that this network is an additional resource and does not replace the current CSUN wireless network.

These instructions are for Android OS 2.2.

### *Android 2.2 WPA2 Setup*

---

1. From the **Home** menu, select **Settings**.
2. Select **Wireless Network**.
3. Select **Wi-Fi Settings**.
4. Select **Add Wi-Fi Network**.
5. Under **Network SSID**, enter **csun\_wpa2** (lower-case).
6. In the dialog box, under **Security**, select **802.1x EAP**.
7. Under **EAP method**, verify that **PEAP** is selected.
8. Under **Phase 2 Authentication**, select **MSCHAPV2**.
9. Under **Identity**, enter your username and password.
10. Select the **Connect** button to complete the setup process.

**Note:** If setup is successful, the network displays and is connected for use.
