

**Tips for Reading the  
 Pre-Credential/ITEP-Junior Option  
 EED and SPED Advisement Forms**

- All courses that are lined up to the *far left* are BA only courses.
- All courses that are *indented* are ITEP courses.
- All courses **outlined in bold** are ITEP-linked courses.
- Choose one course from each section listed.
- Complete courses in the order listed on your advisement form – focus on courses from years one and two, then move on to years three and four.
- Within your first two years of college, decide on a track to pursue – either Elementary Education (**EED**) or Special Education (**SPED MM/MS**).
- Then decide on an option: BA ONLY Option, or the ITEP Option (BA and teaching credential).
- **Pay close attention to courses you may or may not be required to take. (see below) ↓**

**⇒ BA ONLY (EED) OPTION**

1. Take #28, do not take #29
2. Take #33, do not take #34
3. Do not take #37 - #39
4. Do not take #41 - #43

**⇒ BA ONLY (SPED) OPTION**

1. Take #20A, do not take #20B
2. Take #22, do not take #23
3. Take #29, do not take #30
4. Take #34, do not take #35
3. Do not take #38 - #40
4. Do not take #42 - #46

**⇒ ITEP – Junior (EED) OPTION**

After gaining admission into the ITEP-EED program:

1. Take #28 and #29 concurrently
2. Take #33 and #34 concurrently
3. Take #37, #38, and #39 concurrently
4. Take #41, #42, and #43 concurrently

**⇒ ITEP – Junior (SPED MM/MS) OPTION**

After gaining admission into the ITEP-SPED program:

1. Take #20A and #20B concurrently
2. Take #22
3. Take #23
4. Take #42
5. Take #29 and #30 concurrently
6. Take #34 and #35 concurrently
7. Take #38, #39, and #40 concurrently
8. SPED (MM): Take #43, and #44  
 SPED (MS): Take #45, and #46
