The Pre-Credential and the Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP) are designed for future elementary and special education teachers. The Pre-Credential Program provides a BA degree in Liberal Studies ONLY and is best suited for students who wish to enroll in a teaching credential program after they earn their bachelor's degree. The ITEP-Junior Option is for students who would like to earn their BA and credential simultaneously. All students begin in the Pre-Credential Program and take the classes listed below. Students may apply to ITEP as early as their first semester at CSUN. All General Education and Title V requirements are incorporated within the major. **Transfer students should not follow a California State University General Education Certification or IGETC plan.** Information about admission requirements to CSUN may be obtained from the office of Admissions and Records at (818) 677-3700. MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE TRANSFER UNITS: A maximum of 70 semester units may be transferred from community colleges. Students may exceed the 70 unit limit as long as they complete 50 units at a four-year institution (30 of these 50 units must be completed at CSUN).

Students who have applied to CSUN **and** who have completed a workshop may schedule an individual appointment with an advisor after receiving an evaluation from the Liberal Studies Office.
