

# **Supplemental Instruction: Way More Than Tutoring!**

## ***What is Supplemental Instruction?***

University 60 , Supplemental Instruction (SI), are peer-facilitated group study sessions designed to help students master difficult subject matter in classes with traditionally low pass rates. SI Leaders attend the targeted class, read the assigned material, and work with the professors. Sessions focus on understanding content while developing effective study strategies, note taking and problem solving skills, and exam preparation.

## ***What are the SI Leaders' responsibilities?***

SI leaders are responsible for attending class meetings for the selected course, planning and facilitating SI sessions throughout the term using strategies learned through the SI leader training workshop, and attending bi-weekly meetings.

## ***What are the benefits of being an SI Leader?***

SI is a paid position. It is also an opportunity for students to strengthen their communication skills, improve expertise in a given academic subject, and gain professional experience. Being an SI Leader is a great opportunity for anyone who is interested in teaching.

### **Minimum Criteria Needed to Apply:**

- **Must be Junior, Senior, or Graduate standing**
- **Must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher**
- **Must have previously taken the course to be tutored and received a grade of A**
- **Must have good communication and interpersonal skills**
