WHY FOLLOW A TRANSFER GUARANTEE?

Following an approved Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG) provides a direct transition to Cal State Northridge. The agreement guarantees your admission to CSUN in the semester you specify.

Each TAG is designed to provide you a clear route to complete both General Education requirements and the lower division requirements for your major. Completing the agreement at your community college will permit you to earn a CSUN degree without the need to go back and take additional prerequisite coursework.

Following a Transfer Guarantee agreement also gives you a head start in your major by providing an opportunity to learn what your upper division coursework will entail, offering you an opportunity to get to know your major advisor, and giving you an invitation to attend campus events for students in your major.

Students completing a TAG will join a cohort of entering students who have a clear sequence of courses that permit them to complete their bachelor's degree in a timely manner



AM I ELIGIBLE?

A TAG can be established by California residents who have completed at least 15 transferable units and who have not previously been disqualified from attending a CSU campus.

HOW DOES A TRANSFER GUARANTEE WORK?

1. Obtain a copy of the Transfer Guarantee Agreement Contract, from your community college transfer center.
2. Meet with your community college transfer counselor and complete both the Transfer Guarantee agreement and the General Education or IGETC certification plan.
3. Once your community college transfer counselor has signed the guarantee and either a CSU transfer general education certification or IGETC plan, submit them to Cal State Northridge. After they have been processed, you will receive an approval copy for your records.
4. Successfully complete the coursework and any other conditions specified in your Transfer Guarantee agreement and CSU or IGETC plan.
5. Submit your application for the semester specified in your agreement during the period that the campus is accepting transfer applications.
6. Follow registration instructions and become a CSUN matador!

WHAT MAJORS HAVE A TRANSFER GUARANTEE?

All majors offer a transfer guarantee, with the exception of Accounting, Financial Services, and Financial Planning. For a listing of all majors please visit
