

STEPS TO ENROLL AT CSUN

California State University, Northridge

1 Activate your CSUN User ID and Password to log into myNorthridge and the Student Center (SOLAR). Use the SOLAR Student Center to register online and manage your academic, financial and personal information. To set up your account, see www.csun.edu/it/helpdesk.

2 Apply for financial aid. To be considered for financial aid, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Be sure to enter CSUN's Federal School Code of 001153. For priority consideration, file your FAFSA by March 2nd of the year prior to enrollment.

3 Apply to student housing. Students who live on campus at Cal State Northridge have their choice of several housing options including spacious, apartment-style living and more traditional residence hall suites designed to help undergraduates successfully transition to college. Apply by the first week in April to receive priority housing at <http://housing.csun.edu>.

4 Schedule advisement. Academic advisement is recommended for first-time transfer students. When you receive your registration notice [OR Registration Access Mailer], in the mail, make an appointment with your advisor in the college of your major. If Undecided or Undeclared, contact the Advising Resource Center/EOP in the list to the right. Before your advisement meeting, review the "Transfer Student Checklist" at www.csun.edu/ugs/transferchecklist.html.

5 Register for classes online. The myNorthridge Portal is your gateway to the Student Center (SOLAR) and self-service access to your academic, financial and personal information. Use the Student Center to enroll in classes, pay fees, check financial aid, run your Degree Progress Report, view class schedules and more.

6 Register for New Student Orientation at www.csun.edu/nso. CSUN is committed to your academic success. Therefore, it is highly recommended that you attend Transfer Student Orientation to help you learn the essentials of being a successful transfer student.

7 Meet immunization requirements. All students must meet the California state immunization requirements before they complete their first semester of classes at CSUN. Please visit www.csun.edu/~shcenter for more information.

8 Submit final official transcripts. Final transcripts from all colleges and universities attended must be sent to CSUN. Transcripts should be sent directly from your school to:
