Since we like to speak with you prior to your registering for Fall classes, you are all required to have an academic advisement meeting with me, the Philosophy Department's Academic Advisor, before being allowed to register for the Fall 2009 semester. You will have two opportunities to meet with me for advisement: Spring and Summer.


- (1) The Spring advisement period has already started and will end on the 7th of May. During this period, you may come to my office for advisement during my regular office hours: Tuesdays & Thursdays, 10:15-11:15 a.m., 6:00-6:30 p.m. (You do **not** need to make an appointment to speak with me during my office hours; feel free to drop in unannounced.) It might be that I'll be available at other times as well; email me if you'd like to make an appointment, making sure to specify in your email some times at which you're available to meet. Do not call me to schedule an appointment.

If you're scheduled to graduate in December 2009, you must see me during the Spring advisement period. If you don't, you won't be able to register on your assigned day of priority registration in June.

- (2) You can meet with me this summer, when I will be available by appointment for five days in late June or early July (**probably** June 29th through July 3rd) during regular business hours. Details about the Summer advisement period, including instructions for making an appointment, are coming soon.
