'QUEERING RELIGION'**

This course explores the treatment of lesbians, gays, bisexuals, and transgendered people (LGBT and Queer) in Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. It focuses on 1) recovered appreciation for queer religious identities from generally hostile religious traditions; 2) religious homophobia expressed in historical scripture interpretations and religious traditions; and 3) emergent religious trends within these religions that celebrate queer identities and gender diversities.
