This six-session program over three weekends will take you through hands-on training to gain important lifesaving skills for an affordable cost of \$130.

WHY:	Provide prospective lifeguards with an affordable and convenient option to receive training and certification.

Participants are expected to provide their own swimsuit and meet a certain number of swimming and rescue skill pre-requisites. Participants who fail to demonstrate the pre-requisites will receive a full refund of \$130.
