

## Survey Interviewer Position (UCLA RISE UP Study)

The UCLA RISE UP Study is a 5-year collaborative project between UCLA researchers at the School of Medicine and charter schools across Los Angeles County. The study is designed to determine the impact of high-performing schools on educational achievement, health, and health-related behaviors among students. The results will provide extraordinary and compelling evidence for participating schools that not only can education reform be achieved, but also that such reform has a wide range of benefits to society including better health.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** We are hiring **part-time bilingual (Spanish and English) survey interviewers** to work an average of 10-15 hours per week from end of October 2016 through– March 2017 (depending on data collection progress), with the potential to be re-hired for follow-up data collection over the remainder of the study. Interviewers will be responsible for administering a 1 ½ hour survey with randomly selected teens using an iPad provided by the UCLA RISE UP Project. Interviewer must be comfortable traveling to participants' homes or designated survey interview locations (i.e. schools, parks or community centers).

This position is a good fit for someone that is looking for a part-time, flexible schedule including evenings and weekends and must be willing to travel locally.

**TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR FIELD INTERVIEWERS:** All survey interviewers will be required to attend and successfully complete a training session from **8am-4pm on Wednesday, November 2, 2016 at UCLA**. They will also participate in additional field supervised training with a study PI or Field Supervisor as needed.

**DESIRES SKILLS:** Competitive candidates will be available and willing to work evenings and weekends. Must have effective communication skills through speech, listening, and fluency in English and Spanish through reading, writing, and speaking. Must be able to read text from a tablet/laptop screen and paper documents. We are looking for candidates who will be dedicated to performing field work according to study protocol and who are prompt and reliable. Survey interviewers must have regular access to internet connection for data transmission. They must also assume responsibility for and careful tracking of all gift c used for incentive payments. Assume responsibility for use and care of tablets/laptops, taking reasonable and appropriate steps to safeguard them against damage, loss or theft and returning all equipment at the conclusion of the assignment or at the request of the supervisor.

Pay rate: \$16.62/hour

Hours: Must be available a minimum of 3-4 days during the week from about 3:30-7:30pm and at least 2 Saturdays (from about 10am-4pm) a month.
