

The Executive Committee of the California State University, Northridge Faculty Senate unanimously passed the following resolution

Resolved: that the Executive Committee of the CSUN Faculty Senate acting on behalf of the full Faculty Senate express its opposition to any issuance of an executive order implementing the ideas contained in Coded Memorandum #ASA-2017-14, without sufficient time for meaningful consultation with the faculty, who bear responsibility for curricular oversight. Such consultation cannot begin until faculty members are under contract in Fall 2017, and must include a long enough timeline for serious consideration by several relevant Faculty Senate bodies.

We, the undersigned, endorse and commend this resolution to you.


We are excited to be working to improve developmental education. Given the number of students who will be affected by any changes, we must not err. We urge you to weigh the potential for harm alongside the pressures of the timeline you have imposed upon yourselves for this important endeavor.
