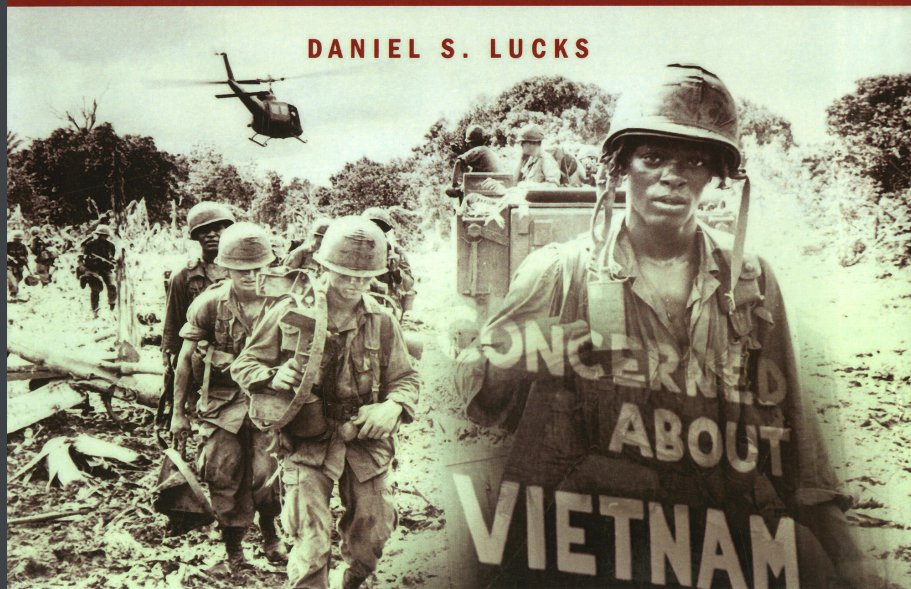


The Civil Rights Movement and the Vietnam War
