

Valid Fall 2013 to Summer 2014

The General Studies Option is designed for students interested in a broad liberal arts education with studies in many subject areas rather than concentrating on one field of study. This option offers students a broad education as well as the opportunity to select an area of specialization. Students selecting the General Studies Option may be interested in pursuing careers in business, law, government, social services, non-profit services, arts, and many other careers. Students interested in teaching Elementary or Special Education should select one of the Teacher Preparation Options instead of the General Studies Option.

Liberal Studies majors in this plan complete their General Education (G.E.) and Title V requirements <u>outside</u> of the major. Even though many of the course choices below count for G.E., Liberal Studies General Studies Option students <u>may not double-count</u> any courses from G.E. within the major. All General Studies Option students must complete 20 hours of community service, an internship, or a service learning class during their course of education. Please consult a Liberal Studies advisor for details on this requirement.

MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE TRANSFER UNITS: A maximum of 70 semester units may be transferred from a community college. Students may exceed the 70-unit limit as long as they complete 50 units at a four-year institution (30 of these 50 units must be completed at CSUN).
