Post-Tenure Review Procedures

As authorized in Section 600, 645.6, the Department of Sociology establishes the following polices and criteria for purposes of Post-Tenure Review as discussed in Section 645, Periodic Review of Tenured Faculty.

- The faculty members under review select three professors of their choosing (tenured full professors) to serve on the Peer Review Committee (PRC). If there are an insufficient number of tenured full professors in the department, tenured faculty at the rank of professor from related academic disciplines may serve. The PRC selects a chair for this committee.
- PRC reviews the faculty based on actual work assignments, which normally include:
 - Teaching Effectiveness (consideration shall include student evaluations of teaching performance).
 - Contributions to the Field of Study.
 - Contributions to the University and Community.
- The process for the submission of written reports, distribution of those reports, rebuttal statements, and meetings as delineated in 645.4, 1-5, will apply.
