

The following is an overview of **SOME** of the NCAA rules that apply to student-athletes attending Cal State Northridge. This is intended to familiarize you somewhat with the terminology advisors and coaches will be using in reference to your academic eligibility status as a student-athlete. However, this is **NOT** a full explanation of your responsibilities as a student-athlete. You should **ALWAYS** consult the CSUN Compliance office for a full and clear interpretation of the NCAA rules for student-athletes.

Full-time Enrollment & 6 unit Rule

- You must be enrolled in **12 academic units** at all times during the Fall and Spring semesters.
- You must PASS **6 degree-applicable** units every term.

24 Unit Rule

- You must complete **24 degree-applicable*** units in a school year (18 units in Fall/Spring).
 - *Degree-applicable units are General Education, Title V, and Major coursework.
 - Electives do not always "count" as degree applicable

GPA

- Minimum CSUN (campus) and cumulative GPA = **2.0**

40/60/80% Rule

(Students who began full-time Fall 2003 or later)

	DEGREE-APPLICABLE UNITS TO COMPLETE Depending upon Degree (BA or BS) and Total Units Required (120-128)		
	BA/BS DEGREE (120 units)	BA/BS DEGREE (124 units)	BS DEGREE (128units)
You must meet 40% of your total degree units by the end of your 4th full-time semester, which equals:	48 units	50 units	52 units
You must meet 60% of your total degree units by the end of your 6th full-time semester, which equals:	72 units	75 units	77 units
You must meet 80% of your total degree units by the end of your 8th full-time semester, which equals:	96 units	100 units	103 units
