$$x^2 + y^2 - 6x + 4y = 3.$$

2. Find the function which is finally graphed after the following transformations are applied to the graph of

$$f(x) = \sqrt{x} + \frac{1}{x}.$$

Write intermediate result on each step.

- a) up 2 units;
- b) reflect about Y axis;
- c) left 1 unit;
- d) stretch horizontally by a factor of 2.

3. a) Find the midpoint M of the segment connecting points $P_1(1, 2)$ and $P_2(3, 6)$.
b) Write an equation of the line containing M and perpendicular to the line

$$y = 2x + 1.$$

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4. a) Specify the domain of the function $f(x)$. b) Find Average Rate of Change from $x=1$ to $x=2$.

$$f(x) = \sqrt{3-x} + \sqrt{x+3}$$

5. Find the composite function $(f \circ g)(x)$:

$$f(x) = x - \sqrt{2x + 3}, \quad g(x) = \frac{1}{x - 1}.$$

6. Graph the piece-wise function

$$f(x) = \begin{cases} 2x, & x < 1 \\ 1, & 1 \leq x \leq 2 \\ -(x - 2)^2, & x > 2. \end{cases}$$
