- 🕒 Discuss which steps in the writing process were most helpful to you and explain why.
- 🕒 Specify which changes provide *evidence of substantial revision* as you moved from your first draft, through the second draft, to third (and perhaps final) version.
- 🕒 Indicate which part of the feedback process was most helpful in your revision
- 🕒 Refer to other classroom activities that helped you develop your essay, e.g. group work, class discussions, conferencing, etc.



🕒 FINAL DRAFT OF YOUR ESSAY – MLA Format: (no tabbing or using space-bar to get to where you want to be on a page)

Entire document should be double-spaced

First page should have this heading at the top left:

Your name

Instructor's name

English 098

Date due with day, month spelled out, and year European style. (e.g. 29 Sep 2008)

- All other pages should have your last name and page number (created as a header in Word or WordPerfect) and right margin aligned.

- As with all other submitted work, the final draft must be keyboarded using Times New Roman font size 12
