Students are required to have a CSUN GPA and overall GPA of 3.0 or higher in addition to meeting the prerequisites.

***** Select three (3) of the following upper-division GE courses: PSY 352, RS 361, COMS 356, PHIL 305.

***** Accounting Electives: ACCT 425, ACCT 428, ACCT 442, ACCT 470, ACCT 495, ACCT 496 A-Z.

Take the Upper Division Writing Proficiency Exam (WPE) once 56 units and the lower division writing requirement are met. The WPE must be completed before enrollment in 400-level courses.

GE Sections: Students need to take a total of 48 units of General Education classes (9 units of Upper Division GE credits and 15 units of lower division business requirements that are also GE courses). In total, students will need qualified GE courses in Basic Skills (12 units), Natural Sciences (8 units), Arts and Humanities (6 units), Social Sciences (6 units), Lifelong Learning (3 units), Comparative Culture Studies/Gender, Race, Class and Ethnicity Studies, and Foreign Languages (6 units), and U.S. History and Government (6 units).
