



Student Travel Awards

**Borrego Springs, CA
March 16-18, 2007**

The California Geographical Society invites faculty members of geography departments and programs in California to nominate a deserving undergraduate and/or graduate student for a travel award to attend the Annual Conference of the California Geographical Society. The award provides \$150 to recipients to offset costs associated with the conference. The award is intended to encourage a student to gain experience from attending a statewide conference, and therefore it is not necessary that the student present a paper, poster, or map. We do ask that award recipients share their experience by submitting a reflection piece on their conference attendance, to be included in the *CGS Bulletin*.

Nominations must be received via email by March 2 and should consist of: (1) a brief paragraph outlining the student's interests and abilities in geography, (2) a copy of the student's registration form and (3) contact information for both the student and the nominating professor. One undergraduate and/or one graduate nomination per department or program, please.
