## **Call for Papers, Posters, and Maps**

Annual Conference of the California Geographical Society  
March 16-18, 2007

Anza-Borrego Desert State Park, Borrego Springs, CA

The California Geographical Society invites geography faculty, students, and professionals to present papers, posters, and/or maps at our annual conference to be held in Borrego Springs, CA from March 16-18, 2007 (presentations take place Saturday, March 17 only). This year's theme is "*Celebrating California's Desert Landscapes*," though we welcome presentations across a broad range of topics, regions, and themes.

### **1. ALL PRESENTERS**

### **2. PAPER PRESENTERS**

All papers must be presented within a maximum 20-minute period, including time for questions. The CGS will provide digital projectors compatible with Mac and PC laptop computers. You must bring a laptop computer and necessary cables. Please familiarize yourself with all hardware and software before presenting. You are strongly encouraged to bring backups and hard copies (transparencies) of all digital media. Screens, standard overhead and slide projectors will be provided.

### **3. POSTER PRESENTERS**
