BLAW OPTION ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the lower division and upper division core courses for the B.S. in Business Administration, each student must select 15 units from the upper division courses (listed below) offered by the Department of Business Law. Either **Law and Economics** (ECON 365) or **The Economics of Antitrust and Regulation** (ECON 411) may be taken for 3 of these units with approval of the Department Chair.

If either course has been taken for the Business Breadth Requirement, that course will not count as a Business Law elective.
