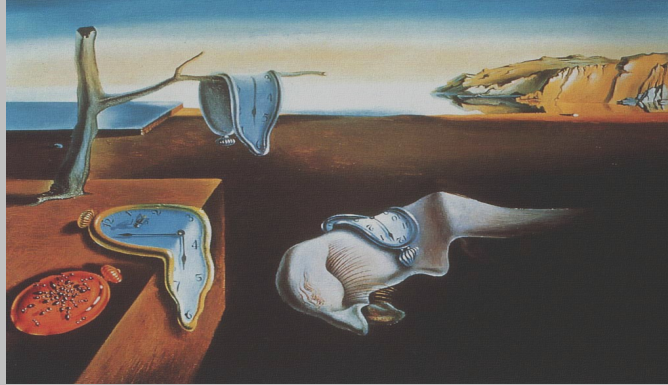


Boundaries (Un)Defined
