Literacy Scholars for the future of Los Angeles (LSLA) Scholarship Guidelines

Program Goals:

- To provide undergraduate scholars with knowledge and understanding of the best research about the process of and challenges to the early acquisition of reading;
- To provide undergraduate scholars with the supervised field work experiences that will prepare them to use these academic tools in working with both classroom and individual children.

Amount of Award: \$1000 (Depending on funding, the scholarship amount could increase. Scholarship recipients will also receive free textbooks in LRS 396L and LRS 496LP/F.)

Deadline: Friday, June 13, 2008

Eligibility:

- A CSUN declared Liberal Studies major who is pursuing either the Pre-Credential (BA ONLY) Option or ITEP-Junior Option.
- Student must have a minimum overall and CSUN GPA of 2.0.
- Must be willing to complete a specialized concentration within the major.
- Must show completion of English 301, Language and Linguistics or its equivalent prior to Fall 2008.
- Must show completion of Linguistics 417, Language Development and Acquisition or be willing to complete it as a co-requisite in Fall 2008.
- Must be willing to complete 15 hours of field work in Fall 2008 and 30 hours of field work in Spring 2009 for a total of 45 hours for the year, if selected.

Directions for Applying:

- Submit a 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Complete the attached Literacy Scholars for the Future of Los Angeles Application Form.
Be sure to include your brief essay explaining why you are interested in participating in the program.

Selection Procedures:

A selection committee will review all applications. Applicants will be notified of the status of their application prior to Fall 2008 registration.

Applications will be reviewed without regard to race, religion, gender, or sexual orientation.
