1. Complete a minimum of 60 transferable semester units with an overall grade point average of 2.00 or better (2.40 for nonresidents) and remain in good standing.
2. Complete at least 30 units of general education which must include all four CSU general education basic subjects courses in Written Communication, Oral Communication, Mathematical Concepts and Critical Thinking* (see table below) **OR** complete the IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum) **OR** complete CSU General Education Breadth Certification Plan.
3. Submit a complete CSU Application for Admission while the campus is still accepting applications for the term listed above. The easiest way to apply is on the web at www.csumentor.edu.
4. Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended for verification of eligibility requirements.
5. Apply for admission to a major which is not impacted and is still accepting new students for the term indicated.

*Critical Thinking is waived for declared Engineering and Computer Science majors.

Please note that the maximum number of units that may be transferred from community colleges to the CSU is 70. It is strongly recommended that you complete the lower division preparation for the major. However, it is not a requirement for admission.
