**Gary Barnett** is presently a music lecturer at the University of California, Riverside. He has performed as a keyboard soloist and collaborative artist throughout the United States and abroad. Barnett holds a Ph.D. in historical musicology from the University of California, Riverside, as well as a DMA in piano performance from the University of Kansas. Master classes and lecture-recitals include the Royal Academy of Music in London, Saint George's School in Rome, the Nanyang Academy of Arts in Singapore, and the National Conservatory of Music in Quito, Ecuador. Following a guest appearance with the Pasadena Symphony, the Los Angeles Times described Barnett as a "thoughtful and meditative piano soloist." The Salt Lake Tribune (Utah, USA) has capitalized Barnett's talent as being "a virtuoso of the highest order."
