- 6. Is there any clear influence of sophistry in Euthyphro's attempts to define piety? Explain
- 7. Do we have any clear understanding of Socrates definition of piety by the end of the dialogue? Explain.
- 8. How would you define piety? Give three examples of piety and explain what makes these acts pious.
