

Tips for using images:

1. Avoid Web Images:

Try not to use images from the Internet. Images are low resolution

2. Look for large images:

If you must use web Images, look for large images on Google

3. Apply a film grain:

If your images are too small and pixilated, use the film grain filter in Photoshop. (Remember to convert to grayscale)

4. Resolution:

Images for the web — 72 ppi (pixels per inch)

Images for your color ink jet printer — 150 ppi

Images for a full color laser print —250 ppi
