

### **Entry Visa Requirements – School Disclaimer**

I have been informed by the Office of Student Development & International Programs (SD&IP) that, although my I-20 or DS-2019 has been endorsed for reentry to the U.S., the entry visa stamp in passport:

\_\_\_\_\_ is expired / expiring (F-1 or J-1)

\_\_\_\_\_ is not the correct visa.

In order to return to the U.S., I will need to visit an American Embassy/Consulate (located outside the U.S.) to:

\_\_\_\_\_ revalidate my expired/expiring F-1 or J-1 entry visa

\_\_\_\_\_ apply for an F-1 or J-1 entry visa.

I have been further informed that, for F-1 or J-1 visa application or revalidation, I will need to submit a valid passport, current I-20 form or DS-2019 form, all previous I-20 forms or DS-2019 forms, a Certificate of Enrollment, an Official Transcript and Proof of Financial Support. Additional evidence may be required to establish non-immigrant intent.

I understand that the decision to approve an F-1 or J-1 student visa is solely at the discretion of the U.S. consular official and that SD&IP has no authority in the visa application or renewal process, and therefore cannot guarantee the outcome.
