


History

- Self-reported symptoms
 - Headache
 - Tinnitus
 - Nausea
 - Vision
- Previous history of concussion

Multiple concussion patterns


- From lighter impacts
- Closer together in time
- Lengthier recovery
- Less complete recovery


Catastrophic head and neck injury must be ruled out before proceeding with a "normal" evaluation!!!




