



#### **GPA REQUIREMENT:**

- CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN ACCT 350 (ACCOUNTING MAJORS), OR FIN 352 (FINANCE MAJORS), OR IS 312 (INFORMATION SYSTEMS MAJORS);
- 1. Major GPA ≥ 3.50 <u>and</u>
- 2. Overall GPA  $\geq$  3.50 or a GPA of  $\geq$  3.50 in the most recent 30 units completed

#### MEMBERSHIP FEE

\$90 initial fee (\$75 to national organization)

#### Commitment




