# Requirements

#### **ACADEMIC**

#### GPA REQUIREMENT:

- CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN ACCT 350 (ACCOUNTING MAJORS), OR FIN 352 (FINANCE MAJORS), OR IS 312 (INFORMATION SYSTEMS MAJORS):
- 1. Major GPA ≥ 3.50 **and**
- 2. Overall GPA  $\geq$  3.50 or a GPA of  $\geq$  3.50 in the most recent 30 units completed
- COMPLETED FIRST RESPECTIVE MAJOR COURSE (ACCT 350 OR FIN 352 OR IS 312)
- 1. Major GPA ≥ 3.30 **and**
- 2. Upper division major GPA ≥ 3.00 and
- 3. Overall GPA  $\geq$  3.20 or a GPA of  $\geq$  3.50 in the most recent 30 units completed

#### MEMBERSHIP FEE

\$90 initial fee (\$75 to national organization)

# Commitment

THE EPSILON CHAPTER BYLAWS REQUIRE NON-INITIATED MEMBERS TO FULFILL AT LEAST 45 POINTS PER SEMESTER IN ORDER TO HAVE GOOD STANDING. EACH HOUR OF AN EVENT COUNTS AS 1.2 POINTS. THE POINTS SYSTEM IS BROKEN DOWN INTO FIVE CATEGORIES:

BAP PROFESSIONAL — 15 POINTS

NON-BAP PROFESSIONAL — 10 POINTS

ADMINISTRATIVE - 5 POINTS

TUTORING - 5 POINTS

COMMUNITY SERVICE — 10 POINTS

TOTAL POINTS - 45 POINTS




