### General Core Curriculum (15 units)

#### *Requirements*

- Take one course from each of the following (a) – (e). Indicate which courses you have completed.

## Research Core Curriculum (9 units)

### *Requirements*

- These following three courses require a grade of C or better for graduation. Complete 301 before taking 497 or 498. It is not recommended to take 497 and 498 at the same time.

## Upper Division History Electives (24 units)

### *Requirements*

- All units in this section must be upper division (300, 400 or 500 level). Note: 500's are graduate-level courses. History 302, 303, 304, 370 and 371 may not be applied to satisfy these requirements. No more than 4 classes/12 units can be at the 300 level. Area requirements include one class each in Europe; United States; and Asia Africa, Latina America, or Middle East.
